Directions to Camp Koinonia: The camp is located just off I-90, 25 miles east of Snoqualmie Pass or 6 miles **west** of Cle Elum. Take exit 78 (Golf Course Rd./E. Nelson Siding Rd.), turn south across the railroad tracks. Go up the hill (1/10th of a mile) and take the first right (E. Nelson Siding Rd.). The entrance road to the camp is to the left about half a mile ahead at the first bend in the road. Watch for the Camp Koinonia sign. The dirt road will wind into the camp. Turn left across the Canal Bridge and look for marker signs to the parking area.
